*Mr.* Gossels was inducted into the United States Army on October 8, 1954. After completing his basic training at Fort Dix, New Jersey, he was assigned to the Intelligence Section of the First Radio Broadcasting and Leaflet Battalion at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. While serving there, he and his unit spent much of their time training Navy pilots to withstand North Korean interrogation and brainwashing techniques. Mr. Gossels' unit was stationed at Fort Polk, Louisiana, for three months in 1955 before returning to Fort Bragg, where he received his honorable discharge and a good conduct ribbon on July 20, 1956.
